

Agreement between Banderia and Utopia for spare parts transfer

This agreement is made as of July 10, 2012 between Banderia and Royal Air Force Utopia. Colonel Colin Sick, as a representative of Banderia, and Colonel Dan Gerous, as a representative of Utopia, desire to transfer spare parts using Worldwide Warehouse Redistribution Service (WWRS) of USAF. Accordingly, all of terms & condition except price will be followed by WWRS procedures.

Banderia and Utopia hereby agree as follows:

1. Establishing Case

Utopia should establish a WWRS FMS case or add a line to an existing FMS case to pay program fees and establish terms and conditions. Once the WWRS FMS case is established, a data set of excess materiel available for sale must be provided. Banderia will use existing blanket order FMS case BD-D-QDC for the type of materiel being purchased.

2. Materiel & Price

Utopia shall sell to Banderia for \$500.00ea/30 items of spare parts, total amount of \$15,000.00 (Annex #1) through WWRS.

3. Shipping

The materiel will be shipped by Utopia to USG Intransit Inspection Point (IIP). Utopia shall bear all costs involved in the transportation of the materiel to the IIP and customs clearance. The WWRS IIP is located in Centerville, Ohio. Shipment to this facility will be addressed with the following Mark For address:

Materiel, that passes inspection, will be sent to Utopia's Continental United States (CONUS) freight forwarder listed in the Military Assistance Program Address Directory (MAPAD) commensurate with the appropriate Military Assistance Program Address Codes. The material will be marked ship to:

4. Title Transfer

According to WWRS regulation, title transfers from the Seller to the USG when materiel passes inspection performed at the IIP or another PMO designated inspection point. Title

transfers from the USG to the Purchaser when the materiel touches the bed of an outbound carrier.

5. Supply Discrepancy Reports

In case of any discrepancy item of over \$200 value, Supply Discrepancy Reports (SDR) will be submitted within one year of the date of the title transfer/date of shipment. SDRs will be filed with the appropriate service ILCO, which is responsible for passing the SDRs to the WWRS PMO. The WWRS PMO facilitates the adjudication of WWRS SDRs.

6. Requisition Process

The detail timeline for requisition process will be discussed at a meeting between the Banderia Foreign Liaison Officer and Utopia Foreign Liaison Office in AFSAC.

Action Item: Suspense 25 July, 2012

The Foreign Liaison Officers of both countries will meet with WWRS PMO. In the meeting, they will discuss and confirm the detail timeline, including loading the items in WWRS inventory and inputting requisitions for transfer process.
